

The Aerosol Society Photograph Competition 2019 Terms & Conditions.

1. The Aerosol Society aerosol image competition 2019 (the "Competition") is open to all Aerosol Society members. All entrants must be an Aerosol Society member both at the time of submission and when the winners are announced at the Society Annual Aerosol Science Conference on November 7th 2019.
2. To enter the Competition, you must sign in as a member on the Aerosol Society website and complete the entry form. You must submit the highest-resolution jpeg photographic image you have, taken by you. You must include your full name and email address with a short caption (maximum 30 words) explaining how the photograph is linked to aerosol science.
3. The closing date for the Competition is the 6th September 2019 at 11.59pm. Entries received after this date will not be considered for the Competition. The Aerosol Society reserves the right in its absolute discretion to extend any relevant closing date where the entries received are of insufficient quality.
4. By submitting an entry to the Competition, You grant The Aerosol Society:
 - a. Permission for your entry to be published on the Aerosol Society website www.aerosol-soc.com, monthly e-newsletter and on any social media account controlled by The Aerosol Society, and you grant The Aerosol Society a non-exclusive, irrevocable, royalty-free, worldwide, perpetual licence to use, republish, edit and/or modify your Competition entry photograph in any/all media (including in electronic format, hard copy and in Society publications) for purposes connected with both the Competition and future Aerosol Society marketing purposes as described in these Terms and Conditions; and
 - b. The right to use your name, affiliation and country of residence for the sole purpose of identifying you as the author of your entry and/or as a winner in the Competition.
5. You also hereby waive all your moral rights in your entry. Notwithstanding the afore-going waiver, in order to use entries as intended and advised in these Terms and Conditions, (i) The Aerosol Society may need to modify entries, including but not limited to resizing, cropping or colour adjustment as necessary, provided that The Aerosol Society shall endeavour in undertaking such modifications to maintain the integrity of your entry as originally created.
6. You own the copyright to your Competition entry as its author. Your entry must be your own work, must not be copied, must not contain any third-party materials and/or content that you do not have permission to use, must not include any trademarks, and must not show inappropriate or dangerous behaviour, or otherwise be obscene, defamatory, distasteful, offensive, or in breach of any applicable law or regulation, or in breach of any confidentiality obligations owed by you to third parties. If The Aerosol Society has reason to believe your entry is not your own work or otherwise breaches these terms and conditions, then The Aerosol Society may not consider it and may disqualify it.
7. Entrants confirm that each individual whose image is featured in the Competition entry has given consent for the use of his/her image in connection with this Competition and in accordance with these terms and conditions.

8. The images will be displayed at the Fundamentals of Aerosol Science 6th November 2019 and the Annual Aerosol Science Conference 7th November 2019 and delegates at these events will be asked to choose one image from all the valid Competition entries received in accordance with these Terms and Conditions (the winner and two runners up). Entrants must not try to influence the selection of the winners.

9. When choosing the winner and runners up, delegates will be requested to look for the best-composed, artistic and original image relevant to aerosol science. The tellers' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

10. The overall winner will receive £100 cash via a bank transfer from The Aerosol Society and 2 x runner up prizes of £50 each will also be awarded via bank transfer.

11. Winners will be notified by The Aerosol Society by email by 15th November 2019 and given details of how to claim their prize.

12. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted and joint submissions are not allowed.

13. We take no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed, misdirected or incomplete or cannot be delivered or entered for any technical or other reason. Proof of delivery of the entry is not proof of receipt.

14. The name and affiliation of the winners can be obtained by sending a stamped addressed envelope to the following address: The Aerosol Society, Office F04a, Kestrel Court, Harbour Road, Portishead, BS20 7AN.

15. The Aerosol Society shall use and take care of any personal information you supply to it as described in its privacy policy, a copy of which can be seen at <https://aerosol-soc.com/privacy/> and in accordance with data protection legislation. By entering the Competition, you agree to the collection, retention, usage and distribution of your personal information in order to process and contact you about your Competition entry, and for the purposes outlined in these terms and conditions.

17. The Aerosol Society reserves the right at any time and from time to time to modify or discontinue, temporarily or permanently, this Competition with or without prior notice due to reasons outside its reasonable control (including, without limitation, in the case of anticipated, suspected or actual fraud). The decision of The Aerosol Society in all matters relating to the Competition is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.

18. The Competition and these terms and conditions will be governed by English law and entrants to the Competition submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.

19. Entrants into the Competition shall be deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions.
